

# Cape York Region Package: Cape Indigenous Mayors Alliance Infrastructure Works Fact Sheet

## June 2016

### What are the Cape Indigenous Mayors Alliance Infrastructure Works?

The Cape Indigenous Mayors Alliance (CIMA) infrastructure works include a number of priority infrastructure projects to be facilitated by the Department of Transport and Main Roads and the Department of Local Government, Infrastructure and Planning, and delivered by Local Indigenous and Council Authorities within their own communities over a three-year period.

The Australian Government approved the program of works in May 2016.

### When will the projects be delivered?

Planning and design for some projects will start in all eight communities this year. The CIMA works will be staggered over a three-year period to maximise employment and economic opportunities. The works must be completed by 30 June 2019.

### The communities that are a part of the CIMA agreement are:

- Kowanyama
- Aurukun
- Pormpuraaw
- Napranum
- Mapoon
- Wujal Wujal
- Northern Peninsula Area
- Lockhart River.

The CIMA Mayors and Council members consulted their communities over a five-month period to determine priority infrastructure projects to be delivered within their communities as part of the Cape York Region Package (CYRP).

### Factors considered were:

- economic impact
- employment and training opportunities
- social wellbeing and cultural significance.



### Funding:

The CYRP is a \$260.5 million program of works to upgrade critical infrastructure on the Cape York Peninsula. The package consists of:

- \$50.5 million for priority community infrastructure works identified by the CIMA
- \$200 million to seal priority sections of the Peninsula Developmental Road
- \$10 million to complete the seal of the Endeavour Valley Road through to Hope Vale

The CYRP is jointly-funded with the Australian Government contributing \$208.4 million and the Queensland Government contributing \$52.1 million.

Community	Planned construction works
Kowanyama	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Construct new barge ramp, hardstand (paved area for heavy vehicles) and concrete causeways</li> <li>Construct and seal sections of access road, including drainage installation</li> </ul>
Aurukun	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Seal the highest priority sections, improve the geometry (horizontal/vertical) and improve drainage</li> </ul>
Pormpuraaw	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Elevate road formation, where required, and install concrete floodways and culverts</li> </ul>
Napranum	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Extend the protective seawall and improve the boat ramp to allow all-weather and tide access</li> <li>Develop the foreshore, including roadway, footpath, general public facilities and areas of cultural significance</li> <li>Construct roadway to proposed commercial facilities on the foreshore, and car parking</li> </ul>
Mapoon	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Wheeler Street - construct 320m of 6m wide bitumen sealed road and rehabilitate a further 200m</li> <li>Gravel and bitumen seal (from Janie Creek turnoff to Cullen Point Road) to 6m width</li> <li>Two-coat seal of 260m of Hudson Street, including improvement of parking at school and hospital and provision of parking at early learning centre</li> <li>Construct 6m wide pavement and two-coat bitumen seal to Thuungu Road</li> <li>Mapoon Airstrip – top-up gravel, widen to 30m and apply two-coat bitumen seal</li> </ul>
Northern Peninsula (various locations)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Injinoo ferry road - prepare and seal pavement and upgrade existing culverts to concrete floodways and box culverts</li> <li>Seisia barge ramp - new berthing dolphins and potential relocation of ramp</li> </ul>
Lockhart River	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Bridge replacement</li> <li>Seal 12.5km of road to 8m width and upgrade culverts and causeways on priority sections</li> </ul>
Wujal Wujal	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Construct concrete pavement to steep incline section</li> <li>Upgrade boat ramp</li> <li>Upgrade various water and sewerage treatment infrastructure upgrades, including a supervisory control and data acquisition (SCADA) computer system for gathering and analysing real-time data, pump station replacements, water treatment membrane replacement and Bloomfield River crossing of water main</li> <li>Construct community municipal waste transfer station</li> </ul>
